More Like SPRING

Lane-Splitting Legislation Moving Forward The Oregon Senate passed (SB422) on March 21st and the House, given some new legislators and a new Governor. The bill only allows lane-splitting in stop & go traffic (speeds under 15 mph) and under other limited conditions and only on certain highways. On March 17, the Judiciary committee

officially recommended that this bill be passed with a single amendment. The Bill is currently before the Joint Transportation Committee to resolve amendments before going to the House floor for a final vote, which has not, yet, been scheduled.

A similar Bill was passed two years ago by the legislature but vetoed by Governor Brown. Activity Report
