We just lost another time member.

Dennis Miles passed away Sunday afternoon October 8th. He had recently been diagnosed with serious cancer and had been placed in hospice care earlier this week. Dennis was 88. He is survived by Bernice, 1 son, 2 daughters, 11 grandkids and 14 great grandchildren.

Bernice doesn't plan on a service, unless their kids decide they want one. Will provide updates if a decision is made. Our thoughts and prayers go out to Bernice and the family.

Weather Report

Fall weather is definitely here. We finally got some rain on September 20th just .12 inches, but much needed. It was only 59°. Thursday the 21st was just 56° and we got a drizzle, barely measurable (.02). I got chilled working in the yard and the house just never warmed up. So had to turn the heat on for the first time since May. Sunday (24th) we got an extended drizzle (.15), but no wind. It apparently drizzled all night adding another .08 inch after midnight.

The last 10 days of September it never got out of the 60s. In fact, Friday the 29th only made it to 55s. Most days were cloudy to partly cloudy skies and some periodic drizzles. The drizzles combined for a total rainfall for September ended up at .68 inch.

Yjkes, the morning of October 1st it was only 37! However, being a clear sunny day, it warmed up to 70°. A Very nice fall day! For the first week of October, we had lots of sunshine and some wind, but not too bad. Friday (6th) it got up to 78. It was 77° Saturday and 84° Sunday and just a slight breeze. Great fall weather!

Monday to 9th cooled off quite a bit only reaching 65°, mostly cloudy with light breeze. Tuesday and Wednesday it didn't make it out of the 50°s. Scattered drizzles Monday through Wednesday dropped .18 inch of precipitation. The rest of the week was in the high 50°s to low 60°s.

The week of the 16th was mostly sunny, with a drizzle on the 16th, but sunny in the afternoon. Wednesday through Saturday got into the 70s with 79° on Friday.

I like the fall weather, but not the shortened daylight hours. We now have less than 12 hours of daylight per day, so sad.
